BBZ

BBZ (Bold Brazen Zamis OR Babes) South London based art & music collective centering femme identity & eradicating misogyny for queer womxn, trans folk and non binary people of colour.



Pempeople

Pempeople's mission is to facilitate and develop the growth and empowerment of their target communities from within, through structured, challenging, rewarding engagement. Alongside their aim to increase, highlight and promote the achievements and successes of disadvantaged communities within society, they help disadvantaged people and communities identify their strengths, enhance their skills, and realise their true potential by helping themselves.

Gal Dem

gal-dem is a creative collective of over 70 women and non-binary people of colour that was born out of frustration of being excluded from the whitewashed mainstream media. Taking over all channels of media, including online, print and live events such as their two V&A takeovers, the Peckham residents will be exploring British women of colour in film. The short films will be followed by a discussion about what it's like to work in an industry that's still overwhelmingly white and male.



Emma Fenelon

Emma is an artist, activist and story teller through her art. Come and make your own mark on tiles made from Peckham

clay with the brief “What do you want to say, what trace do you want to leave behind?”. Young, middling and old, everyone is welcome, clay tiles, vintage letter printing blocks and help provided. The concept being that your individual tile will become part of public art work and tell a story long after the festival.



Movement Factory

The Movement Factory is an award winning community dance empire, home to several initiatives working together collectively to give The Movement Factory a unique and revolutionary presence within the UK Dance industry. They live, eat and breathe community dance and at this year’s festival will be leading Peckham’s first carnival from Holly Grove to Copeland park.



Peckham Peculiar

A free hyper-local, community newspaper for Peckham and Nunhead. Reflecting on Peckham’s history, tackling the area’s current issues and celebrating everything that is Peckham. Born n Bread

BORN N BREAD are a creative collective of friends from South London. They head up a bi-weekly music and lifestyle show every other Saturday morning on NTS. Their zine, available at ICA is centred around self expression and their own culture, how they've grown up, the commonalities, trials, tribulations and life growing up African. Born n Bread will be bringing the house down, closing the Saturday night of Peckham Festival in Copeland Gallery curating the music.

Pomba Girls

A London based network of female performers, dancers, DJ's & event producers united by their passion for immersive experiences. The company has grown into a "tribe" of fiercely ambitious creatives on a mission to galvanise London's events industry. Peckham is 'Pomba' territory, where they sleep, eat, shop and party. Join them on the Holly Grove carnival for a glitter bomb of an experience!

Peckham's Music Scene



The talent and broad array of music is completely limitless coming out of Peckham at the moment. Please be appreciative for the acts that are playing for their community over the weekend and stick around for our secret special guest headliner on Sunday night.



Holy Man Jones

Holy Man Jones are a rock 'n' roll duet featuring the vocals of Colbert Hamilton and Paul Cunningham on guitar, drums and harmonica. Their stomping sound combines the traditional sound of bygone blues artists with modern four-to-the-floor drums. Colbert worked with Thin Lizzy legend Phil Lynette before he died – the track they wrote together, Do You Wanna Rock?, is part of Holy Man Jones' set. Prepare to wear out your rocking shoes.

Kinetika Bloco

Kinetika Bloco bring together the best young brass, woodwind and steel pan players with drummers, dynamic dancers and colourful costumes for a uniquely British carnival experience. Inspired by the sounds of the Caribbean, Brazil and West and Southern Africa, with a sprinkling of jazz, funk and hip

hop, this energetic crew have already played everywhere from Bestival to Notting Hill Carnival. One of the most joyful performances you'll see all year.

Velodrome Music

Velodrome is an experimental alt-rock project from London and Leeds, fronted by the angelically-voiced Katherine Christie Evans. A sweet mix of rock 'n' roll, garage rock and shoegaze, Velodrome's sound is a compelling and catchy meeting of Joni Mitchell, Jeff Buckley and early Kate Bush with sharp-as-knives lyrics. New single His Physique is quirky, upbeat and charming. Velodrome have to be experienced live.

Thidius

Local five-piece Thidius bring with them their brand of compelling electronic rock, which has more than a touch of the psychedelic about it. Mixing melodic grooves and lush

vocals with influences from jazz to soul, electro to African beats, Thidius will introduce a dreamy vibe to our live stage. One of the must-see bands of the festival.

Little Cub

Peckham three-piece Little Cub combine pacy electropop with heartfelt lyrics which explore the complexities of modern love. A little bit Hot Chip, a little bit Friendly Fires and a smidge New Order. These local lads make a polished mix of pop, synth and dance, the perfect soundtrack to euphoric late nights south of the river. The ideal sounds to help you forget your broken heart and dance the night away.



LNLY

LNLY are a hot new dance music collective based in Peckham. They say they are inspired by ‘the mix tapes you used to hear on the car stereo when you were being driven round on a Friday night by your elder sister’s boyfriend’.

Said mix tapes were probably a mix of old school garage, Detroit house, modern pop and classic r’n'b if LNLY’s tunes are anything to go by... LNLY have already done two shows at The Nines this year.

Honey Hahs

The Honey Hahs are three musical sisters from Peckham. Rowan (15), Robin (12) and Sylvie (10) harmonise over simple, heartfelt guitar, bass and drums – each taking it in turn to sing the lead vocals. They started out in venues like local favourites the Ivy House and Brixton’s Windmill, and now have their first record out on Rough Trade. Catch the talented trio now – we think they’re the perfect summer sunshine sound.



Chisara Agor

Chisara Agor is a local girl who grew up on the North Peckham estate, but now divides her time between London and the sunnier climes of Madrid.

The singer-songwriter with the sultry-smooth voice is self-taught at the guitar and ukelele, her influences ranging from jazz, folk, soul and indie-pop, Billie Holiday and Fela Kuti. Her lyrics often touch on social issues, from the refugee crises to the environment. Treat yourself to seeing this Peckham Peculiar cover girl live.

Mohamed Gueye

Keen local drummers will have heard of Mohamed Gueye, the expert percussionist who teaches Sabar and Djembe drumming at the Copleston Centre. Mohamed comes from a family of Senegalese griots – lively performers who combine storytelling with poetry, history and music. Surrounded by rhythm-makers since childhood, Mohamed brings his rich family traditions, exciting technical skills and dynamic, beautifully layered playing to the Festival for the first time.

Athlete Whippet

Athlete Whippet is the 'disks and dance' duo otherwise known as local boys Aviram Barath and Robin Paul Braum. The musical twosome founded record label and music collective squareglass while studying at Goldsmith's university. Their foray into deep hazy house has won plaudits from the likes of Rob da Bank, Tom Ravenscroft and Laurent Garner, while they were recently picked by Mixmag as one of the sounds of 'the beating heart of London'. Come join the party.

Sweat

One of London's hottest bands right now providing 'sexy music for clubs'. With psychedelic grooves and songs

about sex and the apocalypse, this Peckham five-piece are coming to move you – and possibly steal your lovers at the same time. Watch this one if you want to move, if you don't, you're going to anyway. You have been warned.



Shaz Rahman

Shaz Rahman is a hip hop/grime artist from South East London with a trademark sophisticated lyrical style. Motivated by the desire to positively impact his young, inner city urban music fans with meaningful social commentary, Shaz's distinctive flow and versatile style make him to watch.

Peckham Festival by Bike

Discover North Peckham and its artists

This self-directed tour would be best enjoyed on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th September 2017. The first half of the tour can be ridden at a relaxed pace along the quieter roads away from the high street and with short breaks, and is suitable for all riders. The second half is suitable for more confident riders along the Old Kent Road.

Bikes give you better access to Peckham than any other form of transport. When you know where to go and what to look out for, a trusty bicycle enables you to view the area's rich history and cultural significance through a new lens.

To the north of Rye lane, you'll ride on a track first paved by the Romans in AD47 – now known as the Old Kent Road. It's the same path you'll find in Chaucer's Canterbury Tales; that was the scene of the 1415 celebrations for soldiers returning from the Battle of Agincourt; and has more recently become known as the only square on the Monopoly board situated south of the river.

Discover the scores of creative spaces hidden in plain sight along this road. Within the area's 3.5-mile border, Peckham Festival by bike will take you to places you didn't know existed.

Start

Facing Peckham Library, take the cycle path running to the left (the Surrey Canal Path) This long-forgotten canal had once connected to the River Thames.

Cycle up to Glengall Wharf Gardens to see this permaculture in action. This group of local people are keen to get growing sustainably in north Peckham and are developing the site as a resource for local people to share skills related to food and growing. Join in their funday on Sunday 17th September. (64 Glengall Rd, SE15 6NF)



Turn left at the Path crossroads, and left again onto B215 Sumner Road, and first left into Pennack Road. The modern building on the corner of these is ACME Galleria (Pennack Road, SE15 6PW). Located on the site of an old printworks, this 10-storey building houses 149 apartments and 47 studios.

Turn right and right, returning to the Canal path crossroads and this time go straight across to Glengall Road. Turn left onto Bianca Road and follow road round onto Haymerle Road. The large square building ahead is [space] Studios (90 Haymerle Road, SE15 6SD – see map) with almost 70 studios of leading contemporary artists in London.

Continue on Haymerle Road and follow round to the right and you are at Artistic Spaces (7-17 Latona Road SE15 6RX) Formed in 2010 Artistic Spaces has spaces available to creatives at affordable rates without the long and sometimes costly contracts associated with most commercial space.

Cycle straight on, and turn right back onto Glengall Road. Turn right onto Old Kent Road and turn right onto Ossory Road. 100m on your right hand side you will see a sign for Kaymet Works (52 Ossory Road SE1 5AN) Here you will discover the homewares Icon Kaymet and the London Stone Carvers which should not be missed.

Continue along Old Kent Road and turn left onto Sandgate Street, and you will discover the second Artistic Spaces studio complex Action House (53 Sandgate St, SE15 1LE) Visit Shade Abdul Architecture.

Follow Sandgate Street as it curves to the right and changes into Ruby street and Hyndman Street. Turn left onto Old Kent Road, and, after 150m take the first right into commercial Way and onto Bird in Bush road where you will find signs to Livesey Exchange (SE15 1NF) where 60 vacant garages on the Ledbury Estate on Old Kent Road will be transformed into the Livesey

Exchange providing spaces for making, training and cultural programmes and will have a host of activities on Saturday 16th September only.

Return to the Old Kent Road and after 800m turn left into Ilderton Road and cycle 500m before making a left turn to Manor Grove. The next two blocks (Ormside Street) (Hatcham Road) may be unassuming light industrial buildings but many are home to some of the most exciting creatives in Peckham: from prop making to sculpture, fine art and more. Check out DIY Space for London, James Cappa, Studio Makecreate and the Penarth Center where you'll find Ivo Carew Architect.

Return to the Old Kent Road and turn left onto Peckham Park Road and just after the crossroads with Commercial way, turn left into (19 Buller Close, SE15 6UJ) and discover The London Youth Support Trust (LYST): a youth enterprise charity that provides young people with the space and support they need to start a business.

Follow Buller Close to Peckham Hill Street, turn left and you will return to Peckham Library.

Peckham Carnival

Get ready to move and groove as the streets of Peckham come alive this September with the Festival's very own carnival!

Join us from 12pm on Sunday 17th September in Holly Grove behind Peckham Rye train station. The carnival will see performances from amazing musicians, rappers, MCs and dancers, who at 4pm will wend their way in a colourful parade into Copeland Park. Best of all, it's 100% free to attend!

Highlights of the carnival include the spectacular Pomba Girls, a female-driven crew of local performers. The Girls have created crazy costumes sourced from Peckham High Street and inspired by local street fashion - expect bling, sparkles and lots of Lycra. At the Carnival they will be hosting a "Pomba Tribe" initiation which will involve glitter makeovers for local people to come down and get sparkled!

Award-winning local dance organisation Movement Factory are also bringing their Peckham Takeover back for a second year - bigger, better and even livelier than ever! More than 50 singers, dancers, actors and rappers of all ages, plus some special guests, will take to the streets of Peckham, showcasing the very best of our local talent.

We're also excited to welcome the fantastic Desirable Designz Projects, bringing spectacular dancing and costumes inspired by the love of carnival and Caribbean musical heritage and vibes. Especially for Peckham Festival, DD Projects have created a children's masquerade group dancing to fresh soca sounds.

And if that's not enough, you can chill to the sweet sounds of reggae or get up and dance the afternoon away with the awesome New Era Reggae Sound System. DJ Sam Jago, a regular on the reggae circuit, is famous for creating a "jam session" feel by working with live percussionists and singers, including singer Rachel Wallace, Notting Hill Carnival's Alvin Roots, MC Hot Foot and selecta Juno Q Beat. Expect ska, rock steady, roots, steppas, digi/dancehall and reggae turned up to the max at this 100% free family-friendly dance party.
